









Criteria and Requirements for Admission in BDS

The admission in medical and dental education is under the sway of Regulation authority; \ therefore, with respect to the below mentioned matters concerning admission, the applicable criteria and requirements of the authority (available on website: www.pmc.org.pk) shall be followed.

- Eligibility requirements
- * Calculation of merit
- * Complete merit list display
- * Admission offering
- * Structure of interview
- Application/admission process
- * Fee structure
- * Fee refund policy
- * Migration policy

It is pertinent to mention that where there is no rule, regulation or guidance of the authority for any specific matter pertaining to an admission or otherwise, the rules and regulation of the college shall be applicable.

General Policy

Initially, all admissions in MIHS will be provisional. Any candidate, whose particulars, certificates or any other document submitted with the admission form are found to be incorrect or wrong after the verification from the respective examination board, will be struck off from the college roll, even if the candidate has been admitted.

No show cause notice will be necessary for any action under this rule of admission. The candidate who fails to report for interview for admission on the prescribed date shall be considered to have forfeited his/her chance of admission in MCD/ MIHS.

The students of other provinces of Pakistan can also apply if they have appeared in the entrance test. Previous year's entry test will not be accepted.

If any student during his studies at MCD/MIHS does not follow college rules or found violating disciplinary rules, will be liable to be expelled from the college.

All cases of expulsion will be processed by the College Principal and will be forwarded to the Chairman MIHS for final line of action.

Application forms and photocopies of the documents of candidates who are not selected will not be returned.

Disciplinary Rules

- * No person shall be enrolled at the Margalla Institute of Health Sciences, Rawalpindi except on the strict understanding that the candidate intends to obtain his/her professional qualification.
- * Every student is required to attend punctually the required hours notified for lectures and practical classes. He/she must have 75% of total attendance in an academic year to be eligible to appear in the University examination.
- * Students are required to maintain discipline at all times in the college and the hostel or during any other activity arranged/conducted by the Institution.
- * Display and distribution of political party's pamphlets or circulars etc in the college and hospital premises are strictly prohibited.
- * All irregularities, neglect of duties and breach of discipline are to be brought to the notice of the Principal by the teachers under whom the student is working.
- * Leave application must be submitted to the Principal in writing through respective class teacher.
- * All the students are required to pay their tutition fee in advance every year, in case of delay they'll be liable to late fee surcharges which will be @ 2% for first month, 5% for the second & 5% for the third month on the total remaining amount. Furthermore if student fails to submit the dues, after lapse of 03 consecutive months from due date on fee challan/voucher, his/her name will get stuck-off from college rolls and he/she will have to go through re-admission formalities in order to continue studies.
- * If a student fails in supplementary in any session and loses one year, will be liable to pay fee as mentioned in PMC statutes.
- In all cases, the leave taken will be at the students own risk as far as the percentage of attendance is concerned and even a medical certificate will not condone a deficiency in attendance.
- * A student who is absent without leave, continuously for a period of two weeks will be struck off from the college roll.
- * Students are prohibited to address any petition directly to a higher authority/press or unauthorized person.
- * Students desirous of addressing the Principal by a letter must do so individually. Joint application are inadmissible.
- * Any student wishing to make representation on a subject has the right of direct access to the Principal during the college hours at the prescribed time.
- * The Principal, Professors and other staff members are accessible at any time to listen to the difficulties and grievances of the students and shall always be prepared to help them.
- * Non-payment of college/hostel/transportation dues within stipulated time may result in cancellation of admission.

Class Room Discipline

- * When the teacher enters the classroom, the students will stand up and will remain standing till they are directed to sit or till the teacher takes his seat.
- * No student is allowed to leave the classroom without permission of the teacher.
- * Immediately after assembly of the class, the roll call shall be taken . A student coming late in the classroom will be marked absent unless the teacher accepts his /her excuse.
- * Misbehavior of a student shall at once be reported by the teacher to the Respective Proctor through the respective HOD, who will forward case to Chief Proctor and Principal.
- * Students are not allowed to keep their cell phones switched on inside the classroom or where an organized academic activity is going on.

Examination Hall Discipline

- * Students are not allowed to take textbooks, notes, bags or cell phones into the examination hall.
- * Any student found infringing the examination rules or having recourse to unfair means may be debarred from the examination and the matter shall be dealt with according to the University Rules. In case of such happening in the class/terms tests, the matter shall be reported to the Respective Proctor who will forward the case to Chief Proctor and Principal.
- * Late comers arriving at the examination hall more than 30 minutes after the start of the paper will not be allowed to sit in the examination.

Discipline In Hospital

- * Every student is required to attend the clinical teaching and perform ward duties regularly at the notified time.
- * Students attending the hospital are required to abide by the rules of the hospital administration, who may award any punishment to a student committing any offence in the hospital or for negligence in carrying out the duties entrusted to him/her in the hospital. The punishment may amount to debar him/her from attending any or all departments of the hospital for a specified period or impose a fine up toRs. 5000/- as considered appropriate.
- * Every student is required to attend the clinical departments to fulfill the clinical quota as per UHS/PMC requirements.
- * Student attending clinical department are liable to abide by the rules and regulations of the hospital administration.

Any student violating the discipline will be pertinently fined by the Proctorial Board. The board comprises of faculty members that keep an eye on college discipline. Proctors report to Chief Proctor and worthy Principal in writing about violations category wise as per regulations of the "RED BOOK".

Disciplinary Actions

For all offences that occur in the college, hostels or hospital, the Principal and Chief Proctor are empowered to take one or more of the following disciplinary actions depending upon severity of the offence (Apart from directing make well the loss/damage):

The students may be:

- * Asked to render an apology, verbal or written. This will be placed on the student's record.
- * Placed under observation for a period up to one year. If during this period, he fails to improve his conduct, he may be expelled from the college.
- * Fined up to Rs. 500 to 5000/-
- * Suspended from the college rolls for a period of upto two weeks at a time.
- Expelled from the college and expulsion notified to all other medical & dental colleges and universities of Pakistan.

HousingforStudents:

Admitted students can avail the hostel facility provided and managed by the College in nearby areas of the campus. These are beautifully located buildings with Lawns/Terraces having spacious rooms with neat, clean and airy atmosphere. Every room in these hostels have attached bath. Hostel buildings also have a living/TV room, a dining room and a separate study room where students can have their individual /combined studies. Every student is provided with a wooden bed, a mattress, a book rack and a cupboard. In these hostels a full time warden is there to look after and supervise the boarding, messing, cleanliness and discipline of the house. In case of emergencies, first aid is provided within the hostel and if needed, the student can be referred to the nearby hospitals with prior parental permission/consent for further treatment. Shopping trips for the students are also arranged (as per need basis) to different shopping places under the supervision of hostel staff. Another salient feature of our hostels is that strict security measures are ensured and guards remain available round the clock. We also have special arrangement of games like Badminton, Table Tennis, Caroms and Ludos etc. for the students.

Furthermore, no student can leave the hostel premises without prior permission of the hostel authorities and submission of the application. No persons, except the ones specified by the parents, mentioned in the hostel admission application form, are allowed to visit the students. Hostel formulated rules and regulations are to be solemnly abided and adhered by the students while their stay in the hostel.

FACILITIES AT MIHS

Library at a glance

Library is working as the center of information for MIHS community. The department aims to provide most dynamic learning and research environment to the users. Library department fulfills the information needs of the MIHS community, by providing traditional library services as well as streamlines access to wide range of e-resources. The objective of library department is to focus on acquiring right information, processing it and to disseminate the information at the right time to the appropriate users to fulfill their academic needs. We advance the creation, sharing, and preservation of knowledge through the use of latest tools and techniques.

The library consists of a main hall, which is spread over 3000 sq. feet. The professional library staff is available in library. The library timing are from 08:00 hrs to 15:00 hrs during the regular working days, while before and during the examinations, the library remain open till 16:00 hrs. It is well-stocked library with the latest professional books and journals covering all biomedical and clinical sciences. A digital library access is available for students which also has a dedicated link with Higher Education Commission (HEC) and has all the latest journals and periodicals.



Anatomy Museum

Museum is located in the college building in the department of Anatomy. It can easily accommodate 50 students.

It includes models of international standard on human anatomy, embryology and histology, limbs, torso, head and neck, brain, eyes, ear, lungs, reproductive system and pelvis etc. A model of the forearm is used to teach I/V injection. Models prepared by the students and staff of MIHS are the good addition.

One section of the museum exhibits embryology models, which are extremely useful for the demonstration to students. There are also more than 100 natural human bones in the museum.

Pathology Museum

Numerous specimens are taken from the patients' bodies and are preserved in look-through containers for the training of students.

It remains open from 8:00 a.m to 3:00 p.m except on Saturdays and Sundays.






Literary & Media Society

Students are encouraged to join the educational society. In the periodic meeting of this literary society, topics of

interest from latest professional journals and current literature are discussed by the students with participation from faculty members. This society consists of handpicked students with natural talent in fields of media and communication. The job of this society is to cover the events and happenings at



MIHS and provide media support for university publications and data bank.

MIHS produces two publications; a quarterly newsletter, MIHS Chronicles and Healers/Al Shaafi a bilingual annual magazine in order to promote the creative and communicative aspects of learning and provision of a platform for communication and presentation of ideas of students.

These publications are prepared and produced by the dedicated student editorial board under the guidance and encouragement of the experienced faculty editorial board.

Research Facility

The research facilities will be available to the staff members, to promote research in their field of interest. The students in the final year are also encouraged and involved in different research projects. Plans are to start

different research oriented projects in co-ordination with different research agencies such as USAID etc. Online collaboration will also be utilized for this purpose; with different International Medical Research Organizations and the eminent scientists in different fields of medical sciences.

Transport

Air-conditioned shuttle service is available for students and staff on payment.

Margalla Dental Hospital is the teaching hospital of Margalla Institute of Health Sciences and is located at Quaid-e-Azam Avenue, Gulrez-3, Rawalpindi. This hospital consists of 7 Clinical departments and has more than 100 dental chairs. The well experienced and highly qualified teaching staff of Margalla Collage of Dentistry has started training FCPS in Orthodontics and Operative Dentistry since 2010, which have been approved by College of Physcian and Surgeons Pakistan. All latest basic scientific instruments and appliances have been made available in dental hospital for the clinical training of students using the most modern techniques.

Prosthodontics Department

Prosthodontics Department of MDH is equipped with state of the art facility. All kinds of procedures are carried out by competent Doctors, these include; Traditional methods to replace a missing tooth or teeth include the fabrication of a bridge. To replace a missing tooth with a bridge, at least one tooth on either side of the space created by the missing tooth must be prepared for a crown.

When a patient no longer has any natural teeth, complete dentures are the traditional method to restore function and appearance. Many patients experience difficulty wearing conventional dentures because of poor stability and decreased chewing function. The use of dental implants to improve the stability and retention of dentures is becoming quite popular.





These fixtures are placed into the jawbone and allowed to heal until they are "integrated" into the bone. Dental implants may be used to replace one, many or all of a patient's teeth. Porcelain veneers are used to modify the shape and color of teeth. Veneers are thin shells of porcelain that are etched and then bonded to the enamel of the teeth.

Orthodontics Department

Orthodontic Department deals with a way of straightening or moving teeth, to improve the appearance of the teeth and how they work. It can also help to look after the long-term health of your teeth, gums and jaw joints, by spreading the biting pressure over all your teeth. Many people have crowded or crooked teeth. Orthodontic treatment will straighten the teeth or move them into a better position. This can improve their appearance and the way the teeth bite together, while also making them easier to clean. Following treatments are carried out at Margalla Dental Hospital.

Simple treatment may be carried out with a removable brace (a plate that can be taken out to be cleaned). It has delicate wires and springs attached, which move the teeth using gentle pressure.

It is sometimes possible to change the way the jaw grow, using a functional brace. This works by using the power of your jaw muscles and can help with certain types of problem. Often, teeth need to be guided more accurately than they can be using removable braces. So fixed brace is used. This has brackets and bands which are temporarily stuck to the teeth. A flexible wire joins all the brackets and allows the teeth to be moved. You can't take the appliance out yourself, so it is called a fixed appliance. When treatment is finished the teeth need to be held in position for a time. This is called the 'Retention' period, and the appliances that hold the teeth in place are called Retainers.

The retainers hold newly straightened teeth in position while the surrounding gum and bone settles. The retainers can be removable or fixed, depending on the original problem.

Oral Surgery Department

Oral and maxillofacial surgery is to correct a wide spectrum of diseases, injuries and defects in the head, neck, face, jaws and the hard and soft tissues of the oral and maxillofacia region. It is a recognized international surgical specialty. An oral and maxillofacial surgeon is a regional specialist surgeon treating the entire craniomaxillofacial complex, consisting of the mouth, jaws, face, skull, as well as associated structures,

We know the prospect of any sort of oral surgery can be daunting. That is why we carefully explain the process to our patients and make sure they understand what will happen during the surgical procedure. We also give patients full pre-surgery and post-surgery instructions so they can be fully prepared.

Operative Dentistry

Restorative Department provides comprehensive restorative dentistry for patients who suffer from common oral health problems that require necessary care. These techniques can overlap with cosmetic dentistry procedures as modern restorations are designed to look and feel natural or improve one's existing appearance.
